Let's report the safety to Chiba University Safety Confirmation System(ANPIC)

Chiba University will introduce the "Safety Confirmation System (ANPIC)" from March 2023. This makes it possible to aggregate the safety information of students, faculty members, and employees in real time in the event of a disaster and use it for prompt disaster response.

Students, faculty members, and employees should make [initial registration for ANPIC](#) in case of an unpredictable large-scale disaster, and make sure that they can report their safety.

★ Implementation Disaster Drill for AY 2022 ★

A disaster drill including a safety report drill will be held on **Thursday, March 16, 2023**. On the day of the drill, a safety confirmation request will be issued around **11:00 a.m.** Students, faculty and staff are requested to complete the safety report by Friday, March 24, 2023, referring to the above information.
